- Must be at least 16 years of age
- · Have an approved volunteer application
- · Have a valid email address
- Attend orientation to learn shelter basics
- · Complete two trainings in desired area
- Pay \$25 volunteer fee
- Agree to follow all safety and protocol requirements
- · Commit a minimum of 4 hours of time a month long-term
- \* We are unable to accommodate volunteers who have charges related to sexual misconduct, assault/battery, theft, or animal related offenses.

### **VOLUNTEER PROCESS**

- Step 1: Complete online application via our website
- Step 2: Schedule orientation with volunteer coordinator
- Step 3: Schedule first training in desired area with volunteer coordinator
- Step 4: Schedule second training in desired area with volunteer coordinator
- Step 5: Begin self-scheduling and volunteering!





# CAT CARE

Time: 8:30AM-12PM (at least two hours within this time frame)
Description: Cleaning cat areas, scooping litters boxes, refilling food and water bowls, sweeping and mopping, restocking supplies, emptying trash and accessing cats' health and well-being.

## AFTERNOON CAT CARE

Time: 2PM-6PM Monday - Saturday (two hours in this time frame),

2PM-4:30PM Sunday

Description: Recleaning any messy cages, refilling water, cleaning empty

cages, setting up cages, re-scooping litter boxes.

# SMALL ANIMAL CARE

Time: 8:30AM-12PM (approximately two hours in this time frame)
Description: Cleaning and setting up cages, refilling food and water bowls, sweeping and mopping floors, restocking supplies, emptying trash, providing enrichment, and assessing health and well-being of small animals.

### DOG WALKING

Time: 8:30AM-10:30AM and 2:30PM-4:30PM

Description: Walking dogs in assigned room to fenced in play yard. Playing with, socializing, and working on good behavior. Scooping feces from yard and kennels, refilling water bowls, mopping urine from floors and accessing health and well-being of the dogs.

#### **BIG DOG BUDDIES**

Time: 8:30-6PM Monday - Saturday, 8:30AM-4:30PM Sunday

Description: Paired with a dog to take to dog friendly places (parks, stores, etc) twice a week for one hour to help provide additional enrichment and indepth information about the dog's personality and behavior.

#### VACCINE CLINIC ASSISTANT

Time: Saturdays 7:15AM-2PM

Description: Assisting customers with paperwork and questions and

restocking supplies.

### SPAY AND NEUTER CLINIC ASSISTANT

Time: 9AM-3PM

Description: Cleaning and sterilizing all laundry, tools and cages utilized by our clinic patients. Setting up clean cages, preparing food, sweeping and mopping, restocking supplies and emptying trash.

#### ADOPTIONS ASSISTANT

Time: 12PM-6PM (two hours in this time frame)

Description: Clean adoption rooms, assist customers with application process, put animals from meet and greets back in their cages/kennels, answer adoption questions and share animal care information.

\*Must be a volunteer for 6 months or longer

Time: 8:30AM-4:30 Sundays and Mondays,

8:30AM-6PM Tuesday - Saturday

Description: Washing/sanitizing bedding, toys, and food and water bowls

Description: Assist guests with adoption process and questions, monitor lounge cats, scoop litter boxes, feed and refill water and clean up any

messes.

# HAPPY TAILS CASHIER

Time: 9:45AM-1PM and 1PM-4:15PM Friday and Saturday

Description: Check out guests using Square POS system, wrap fragile items

and bag items.

### HAPPY TAILS PREP CREW

Time: Varies

Description: Transport donated items from donation trailer, clean, price

and sort items, put items together.

Description: Answer phones, assist walk-ins, get dogs out for Mutt's Morning Out Program and assist participants with outing reports
